- You can wear a special wristband with your seat number on it ask for one at the ticket office OR ask your grown up if you can look after your ticket or they can write down your seat number on some paper for you.

- Balls can fly into the crowd, especially during warm-ups.
- They can hurt if they hit you, so always keep an eye on the pitch.

In case of an Emergency

Stay calm and follow your grown up if you need to leave quickly.
