Meeting Notes

A meeting was called at short notice in order for the Fan Advisory Board to raise and highlight concerns around the club's league position, dismissal of Vitor Pereira with subsequent speculation on a replacement and general dissatisfaction amongst the fan base. Prior to meeting an open letter on behalf of several fan groups and content creators was received by the club. The Wolves 1877 Trust, who were one of the groups represented on the open letter, are represented on the Fan Advisory Board and it was confirmed that discussions from this meeting would be communicated to wider group who had written the open letter via the 1877 Trust representative.

Conversations in the meeting were constructive with both parties able to talk openly in relation to strengthening confidence and communication moving forward. The club highlighted that they were currently focused on finalising the appointment of a new head coach with a thorough process in place which would hopefully lead to an appointment of a coach and backroom team that could lead the team forward after a difficult start to the season. It was confirmed that the new appointment would come in with full support and with a long-term view and a clear commitment to stability and progress.

The FAB members raised the open letter from fan groups and, whilst being understanding that the club's priority was to complete the recruitment process, felt that an acknowledgment or response to the letter was important and failure to do so could lead the fan groups and wider fanbase to believe that the club had disregarded the concerns that had been raised.

The club were understanding of this position but had concerns as they did not want to simply publish a statement that was not constructive. It was agreed that the club would reply to the groups that sent the open letter directly and that, following the appointment of a head coach, would remain open to respectful and constructive dialogue and continue to engage through the channels already in place whilst working with the Fan Advisory Board to explore further dialogue with other groups in the future.
